12 years- college age		Teen handout Vaccination info sheet Testicular/ breast self-exam (boys/ girls age 14) PSC-17 (pedi screen) – 12 year olds PHQ-9 (teen screen) – 13 – 17 year olds PHQ-9 (adult screen) – 18+	Hemoglobin – all girls with menses, 9 th going into 10 th grade Check urine – 15 year olds Lipid screen – 18 year olds HPV vaccine (human papillomavirus) Catch up on vaccines if needed Menactra booster (on or after 16 th birthday) Bexsero (Meningitis B) 2 dose series minimum 4 weeks apart (as requested for college age kids)

***Kinrix – DTaP + Polio
